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What is LCAP?



- California launched a significant change to how schools are funded about three years ago.
- This new Local Control Funding Formula determines funding based on an unduplicated count of students who meet the criteria set by the state for low income, English Language Learners and Foster youth.
- As a result, each school is required to create a Local Control and Accountability Plan often called the LCAP.
- As we finish the year under our current Local Control Accountability Plan, it is time to evaluate how it went and what would we like to change for next year. A survey went out in April asking parents, students and staff this question and South Sutter had **101** stakeholders complete the survey.




Goal #2: Increase the achievement of low performing students in English and Math.

- Provide traveling wet labs for A-G students.
- Offer more online intervention curriculum choices.
- Offer classes at a SSCS learning center for all ages that include topics of history, math and writing.
- Provide intervention classes or a resource room
- Improve the quality of instruction with online vendors (offer training?)
- A-g classes and curriculum are expensive. It'd be nice to have funds to help students with the cost of being a-g.
- Provide more courses with Highly Qualified teachers for a-g requirements.
- Notify parents early in the year that their student qualified for tutoring and/or curriculum
- Use a mobile learning center for parent information nights, in person curriculum days, etc.
- Additional guidance for what to do in high school level and additional parent-choice activities for high school
